1. These Shows will run under AAA Ltd & HSAA Ltd rules.
2. All horses must be registered with the AAA Ltd and riders/strappers must be current AAA Ltd members.
3. Amateur members also must be current 2011-12 members of the Amateur Association.

5. Highpoints will be calculated using the AAA rule 5.24 and tie breaker rule 5.27
6. *** Class's 64, 68, 69, 70 please note entries into these class's are ineligible to enter in any other equivalent youth class's
7. Youth competing on more than 2 horses can nominate 2 horses towards their highpoint awards for the show.
8. Amateurs competing on more than 2 horses in the Am Junior or Am Senior Horse, can nominate a maximum of 2 horses towards their highpoint awards for the show
9. Limited Amateur are able to enter both Limited Amateur & other Amateur & open class's
10. Amateur Masters are able to enter other Amateur class's & open class's
11. **2 or 3yr old horse** that enter in a Junior Horse class when there is a 2 or 3yr old class available they are unable to enter in both. E.g. you can enter only one of the following; 3yr Western Pleasure or Junior Horse Western Pleasure not both
12. The Committee has the right to alter the order of events or program if needed.
13. Dogs must be kept on leash's at all times and are not permitted in the arena
14. No smoking in the Arena.
15. The committee does not accept responsibility for any accident or injury to any rider, competitor, handler, spectator, horse or property. All riders, handlers & competitors take part at their own risk.
16. Prize money on all Open and Amateur Class's are available for collection 1 hour after the completion of the class and is paid to 3rd place
17. Vouchers for class trophies will be given to all 1st place recipients; you are able to collect your trophy at the secretary van at the completion of the class.
18. Suitability for Dressage & Led Hack; 1 competitor per horse entered in the class in show attire (no strappers in the arena)
19. Open Feature Class's F1, F2, F3, F4, F5 & F6; prize money jackpot will be paid as follows 1st: 40%, 2nd: 25%, 3rd: 15%. And will be available at the conclusion of the show by Chq only
20. Superhorse Trophy; to qualify competitors must enter 4 of the 6 Open Feature class's
